Day/Date	Plan for the day	Options
Arrival Plans	Arrive Tortola either from St. Thomas or fly directly to Tortola, BVI. If you come in to the USVI, you can catch a ferry from Charlotte Amalie, St. Thomas to Soper's Hole, Tortola.	
May 15th	If you arrive early, the day is on your own. Enjoy the sights and stores of Tortola or relax on the beaches.	See listing for hotel and transportation options.
May16, Sun Day 1	Meet us at the Pusser's Landing Café in Soper's Hole on the patio at 1pm. We will board the boats at 2pm and soon sail to the Bight at Norman Island to spend the night. Dinner on board and dancing and drinks on the William Thornton Floating Bar & Restaurant (Willy T).	Enjoy a hike onshore. Behind the Pirates Bar is a trail that leads to the top where you get a great view.
May17 Mon Day 2	Enjoy a morning exploring the caves on Norman Island and sunning yourself on deck. At 1pm, scuba divers will head out to dive the Indians while the rest of us set sail for a short ride to Cooper Island where you can relax on the beach while drinking the famous Painkillers at the Cooper Island Beach Club. We highly recommend starting our dinner ashore this evening with the excellent conch fritters at the Club.	Dinghy over to the caves of Norman Island for snorkeling and exploration. Dinghy ashore at Cooper Island for drinks and shopping.
May18 Tue Day 3	Catamarans will depart around 10am for the world famous Baths while the divers depart at 8:30am for the wreck of the Rhone. Swim or dinghy ashore to enjoy exploring the Baths or the island. Spend the night on Virgin Gorda. Dinner ashore at the Fat Virgin Café.	Lunch at the top of the hill at Mad Dog Cafe and cocktails and a swim in the nearby beautiful pool.
May19 Wed Day 4	Depart at 9am for a sail to Leverick Bay and the Bitter End Yacht Club. Depart in the early afternoon for the short sail to Marina Cay for the night. Spend Happy Hour ashore and enjoy grilled dinner on board.	Happy hour with Michael Bean from 4:30 – 7PM with free local rum shots.
May 20 Thur Day 5	Depart at 8am for Anegada. Enjoy the day exploring this quiet and lightly inhabited island. Enjoy a lobster dinner on the beach this evening.	Take maxi taxi to far side for snorkeling and lunch at Big Bamboo.
May21 Fri Day 6	Depart around 9am for a sail to Great Harbor on Jost Van Dyke. Explore the nearby islands, snorkel and relax on the white beaches ashore. Come back to the boats for the Rovia Blue Party. Don your wild blue gear, grab a blue cocktail and qualify for \$100 off your next Dream Trip! Dinner ashore at Sidney's Peace & Love.	Visit the many fun beach bars for a great lunch and beers in one of the pretty places in the BVI.
May22 Sat Day 7	Sail around towards Little Jost Van Dyke and enjoy a morning exploring. Drop the hook at White Bay for lunch ashore at Soggy Dollar Bar Enjoy the quiet and stars on your last night on board.	Visit the small natural pool near Foxy's new place or visit Diamond Cay National Park on Little Jost to enjoy the flora and fauna.
May23 Sun Day 8	Turn in boats at noon and prepare to head home. Take the ferry to St. Thomas or depart from Tortola to the US.	

Voyage 440 Premier Plus Catamaran with Air Conditioning

There's a lot to be said for this truly lovely yacht! Classic styling, performance under sail, innovative design, functionality ... the Voyage 440 has it all and then some!

This catamaran packs a lot of punch into just 43'8"!, has an on board generator with air conditioning, a very workable galley adjacent to the bright and airy saloon (with seating for 8) and sliding glass door walk out to the cockpit.

The navigation station and office area opposite the dinette is the ideal spot to keep your laptop while making use of the WIFI connection available right at the dock!

The 440 was named "Boat of the Year" in 2002 by Cruising World Magazine ... and deservedly so! All four cabins with en suite head and shower enjoy complete privacy with the placement of the individual, private heads amidships.

On deck, the Voyage 440 features a teak dive platform upon which your dinghy may be stored while underway. Good sized sugar scoops with molded stairs and swim ladder allow easy access to the water or dinghy.

This cat is quick, tacks well and rides beautifully. Book your British Virgin Islands yacht charter aboard this air conditioned catamaran early to avoid disappointment. There are only three in the fleet with air conditioning!
