

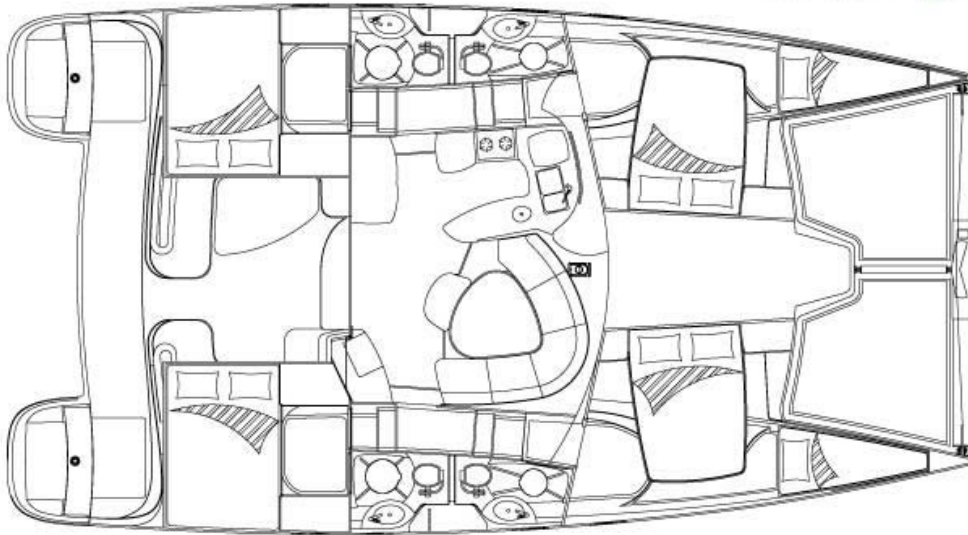

**Getting There Fly into (STT) St. Thomas or (EIS) Beef Island, VI and either take the ferry from STT or a taxi from Beef Island to Roadtown, Tortola.**

**Ferry Service. St. Thomas has ferry service from its downtown Charlotte Amalie dock near the airport. The ferries (\$50/28 round trip/one way for adults, Road Town on Tortola.**

**Given its small size, assistance with luggage (despite offers) is generally not needed to walk the few steps to the ticket counters inside and adjoining departure areas for the ferries**
